## **ISA Standing Committees**

### Education and Professional Standards Committee

The President makes appointments annually with approval of the Board for a term of two years, with a maximum of three terms, as vacancies occur. The Committee develops strategies to standardize and enhance the quality of entry-level interactive surgical technology education for the ISA student members, CE delivery and availability for ISA assembly, and increase partnership with CAAHEP approved, Indiana Surgical Technology programs.
